Day 0 = Symptom Onset (or Test Date if Asymptomatic)

Day 0 = Most recent day the individual was in close contact with a positive case

ISOLATION FOR ANYONE WHO HAS COVID-19:

- Regardless of vaccination status, stay home for at least 5 days.
- If asymptomatic, or if symptoms have improved after day 5 (and no fever in 24 hours without fever-reducers), the individual may resume activities, but must wear a mask through day 10.

QUARANTINE FOR CLOSE CONTACTS IF UP TO DATE ON COVID-19 VACCINATION:

(Received primary series & recommended boosters)

- Continue activities with precautions and wear a mask through day 10.
- Get tested on day 5

If symptoms develop, get tested and stay home for at least 5 days, or until symptoms resolve.

QUARANTINE FOR CLOSE CONTACTS IF NOT UP TO DATE ON COVID-19 VACCINATION:

- Stay home through day 5
- Get tested on day 5
- Resume activities with precautions and wear a mask through day 10.

If symptoms develop, get tested and stay home for at least 5 days, or until symptoms resolve.
